PARENT TEACHER CONFERENCES

Parent teacher conferences are taking place on October 17 and 18. **Please book a time online (beginning Tuesday, October 10) on Parent Connect** (see instructions on back of newsletter), with your child's teacher to discuss how the beginning of the year has gone, and how you can partner with your child and your child's teacher to support his/her learning. There is much research that shows a positive and strong home school connection benefits student learning.

HEALTHY HOME / SCHOOL COMMUNICATION

Students benefit greatly from strong, positive communication between the home and school. It is helpful to:

- Contact the teacher when you have information or a concern. Usually a face-to-face or phone conversation is best for more detailed information.
- Keep email communication short and sweet. Longer emails are the form of communication most likely to be unhelpful, due to the inability to clarify understandings/perceptions, and the lack of body language, facial expression and tone of voice.
- Follow due process with concerns (most of the time). Start with the teacher, and then move on to the principal/vice-principal if you are not satisfied.
- Keep in mind that gossip in any form (spoken or on line) is unhelpful and sets a poor example for our children.
- Speak well of the school and the adults who work there in front of students, especially when working through issues of concern. We need to be a team.

DROPPING OFF YOUR CHILD'S LUNCH?

We have a counter near the front office for parents who need to drop off their child's lunch. Paper, a pen and tape are available so that you can tape your child's name (first and last name) to the lunch. Please let your child know ahead of time that you will be dropping it off, so that they know they should come down and pick it up. If we notice that the lunch break is underway and a student has not come down to pick up his/her lunch we will call them down to the office to get the lunch. ***Please do not go to your child's classroom to deliver their lunch to them and do not stop/park in the school fire lane. Instead, partner with us in helping to instill in your children their independence at going to retrieve their lunch from the table.***

ELECTRONICS AT SCHOOL (i.e. Cameras, cell phones)

A reminder to all parents and students that the school understands that many parents feel that it is important for their child to have a cell phone for emergency purposes. At Richardson, **all electronics, including cell phones, are turned off and put away while at school.** Under no circumstances should students be using electronic devices during school hours (unless requested by their teacher). We have many students whose parents have asked that their child not be photographed. If you need to get in touch with your child, please contact the office and we will get the message to your child in a way that would cause the least interruption to instructional time. Thank you!

PARENT CONNECT

Please make sure that all phone numbers that we have for you, your spouse, or other **emergency contacts** for your child(ren), are current and up-to-date. The inability to contact an adult in any type of emergency, medical or otherwise, can be very distressing for a child. All updates are made on the **Parent Connect system.** We use this information as our Emergency release data in case of an earthquake or any other major emergency.

By logging into Parent Connect, families also have the ability to update email addresses, medical information, as well as give consent for **photos, electronic communications, outside media in schools, walking field trips,** and our **Fruit and Veggie** program. Please note that if you do not give your consent on Parent Connect, your child will **not** be able to participate in these activities.

HOW TO BOOK YOUR APPOINTMENTS

1. Sign in to your Parent Connect account
<https://cimsweb.deltasd.bc.ca/schoolconnect/parentsignone.aspx>
2. Select the "Intrvw" tab at the top of the screen (Parent Interview Schedule)
3. Select the child for which you want to schedule appointments (if there is more than one child in the family, use the drop down selection box to select the appropriate child)
4. Select the Homeroom Teacher ID in the Select a Teacher field. The available schedule will be displayed in date/time order making it easy to scroll down through the list and select the best available time. The selection will be moved to the panel on the right.

If you select a specific teacher, or a specific date, or a specific time range, and the system does not display any time slots, then that means there are no appointments available for the teacher for that date and for those times.

**** Remember to leave one time slot between appointments for walking time ****

5. If you want to cancel an appointment immediately after you selected it, just click on the "Cancel" button. If you want to cancel an appointment after you either moved on to the next child or left the program, go back and select the appropriate student and teacher and click on the "Cancel" button for the selected appointment. Your appointment will be cancelled and removed from the list on the right.
6. If you would like to make an appointment with the Resource Room teacher and/or ESL teacher and/or LA teacher, etc., then unselect the "Limit to who teaches this student" checkbox and the Select a Teacher drop-down selection will now show ALL teachers in the school. Select the appropriate Teacher and book an appointment.
7. Print a hard copy of your interview schedule once you have made all your appointments and bring this schedule with you to the school. The interview schedule will indicate where each teacher is located in the school.
