Kindergarten Registration (English)

Kindergarten registration for September takes place mid-February each year. A child may be registered to attend Kindergarten in September if their fifth birthday occurs on or before December 31st of the current year.

Kindergarten registration for the 2025/2026 school year will be held from February 10-25, 2025. Please register ONLINE for your <u>catchment</u> area school during this period of time. In-person registration at Richardson will be available on Thursday, February 13. For verification of your catchment area school, please check the School Locator. Instructions on how to register will be posted on the district website in early February.

Please have the following documents ready to upload with your child's registration <u>(all documents must be</u> received for registration to be accepted):

1. Proof of birth date for the student (birth certificate or passport) (registration will not be accepted until proof of birth date is received).

2. Proof of citizenship for both the parent and the student (Canadian birth certificate, citizenship card, passport, landed immigrant document, permanent resident card).

French Immersion Enrolment Process

There is an *Enrolment Process* by which families need to proceed if interested to register a child in a French Immersion Program, either for the Early French Immersion Program or the Late French Immersion Program. An application form needs to first be completed and submitted by the deadline of each year, which demonstrates a *commitment* by the families to register their child in the designated program if their child is accepted and to understand that **there is a commitment for the child to stay in the French Immersion program until Grade 12**, where families understand that their support and encouragement will be very important throughout the child's journey of learning in the French Immersion program.

This year, parents must apply online by entering their details, their child's details (one application per child), indicate their French Immersion school choices in order of preference and submit their application by the appropriate deadline:

Early French Immersion (Kindergarten-Grade 12) 4p.m. on January 22nd

Late French Immersion (Grade 6-Grade 12) 4p.m. on February 12th

Photos, Videos and Privacy

Social networking sites (Facebook, Instagram, etc.) are often used to share photos and videos of family and friends. While this is an efficient and convenient venue for sharing family photos, it presents challenges when video or photographs are taken at a school event and include other children from our school community. In the interest of respecting potential family sensitivities and the privacy of others, if other children are identifiable in your photos or videos taken at school events, please obtain permission from the children's parents before posting on the Internet. Alternatively, post photos or videos in which only your own children can be identified.

Drinks at School

At Richardson, students are encouraged to bring a full water bottle to school each day. The water bottle can be kept with the student at their desk or in an easily accessible location that the classroom teacher has identified. During the lunch eating time, students may drink juice boxes or other such drink choices that parents have chosen to provide. At the end of the eating time, it is expected that these 'other' drinks are finished or put away according to teacher instructions. Such drinks must be easily resealed. This is to avoid sticky spillage which can damage student work. Additionally, parents are asked to refrain from delivering drinks other than water during the school day.

Also, please ensure students have a full change of clothes at school. The wet and muddy conditions outside often necessitate a change into clean and dry clothing after the playtime.

Student Illness/ Reporting Student Absences

Just a reminder to check student wellness before coming to school. If symptoms of illness are present, please assess whether students are better off staying home. We have had many unwell children at school this week who have had to be picked up. **Also, please be** sure to call or email our office to notify the school if your child will be absent for any reason.
