All schools in the Delta School District will remain **OPEN** if at all possible during winter weather, including snowfalls.

- 1.Any district-wide closure will be decided by **7 a.m. at the latest** and will be announced through the media, as well as through the district and school websites and social media. Please note: No announcement will be made stating that specific schools are open. Only closures and delayed openings will be announced.
- 2.Student safety is the first priority of the Delta School District. Parents/Guardians are responsible for their children's safe travel to and from school.
- 3. Schools will be kept open except under extreme circumstances to provide the option of attendance for all, but the decision to attend is the responsibility of each family.

4.During extreme weather conditions it is also common for police and other authorities to advise citizens to avoid unnecessary travel. Parents should take this advice as well. Students will not be penalized for lack of attendance under such poor weather conditions.

Drop-off/Safe Arrival

Our morning drop-off time is very busy in our back driveway and around the school. All students should strive to be on the school grounds by 8:50 to be on time. Students arriving after the warning bell at 8:55 are still expected to go to their class lineup. When students arrive after 9:00, they must enter through the front doors in order to sign in. We appreciate the support of families in getting students to school on time.

Kindergarten Registration (English)

Kindergarten registration for September takes place mid-February each year. A child may be registered to attend Kindergarten in September if their fifth birthday occurs on or before December 31st of the current year.

Inperson registration at Richardson will be available on Thursday, February 13. For verification of your catchment area school, please check the School Locator.
